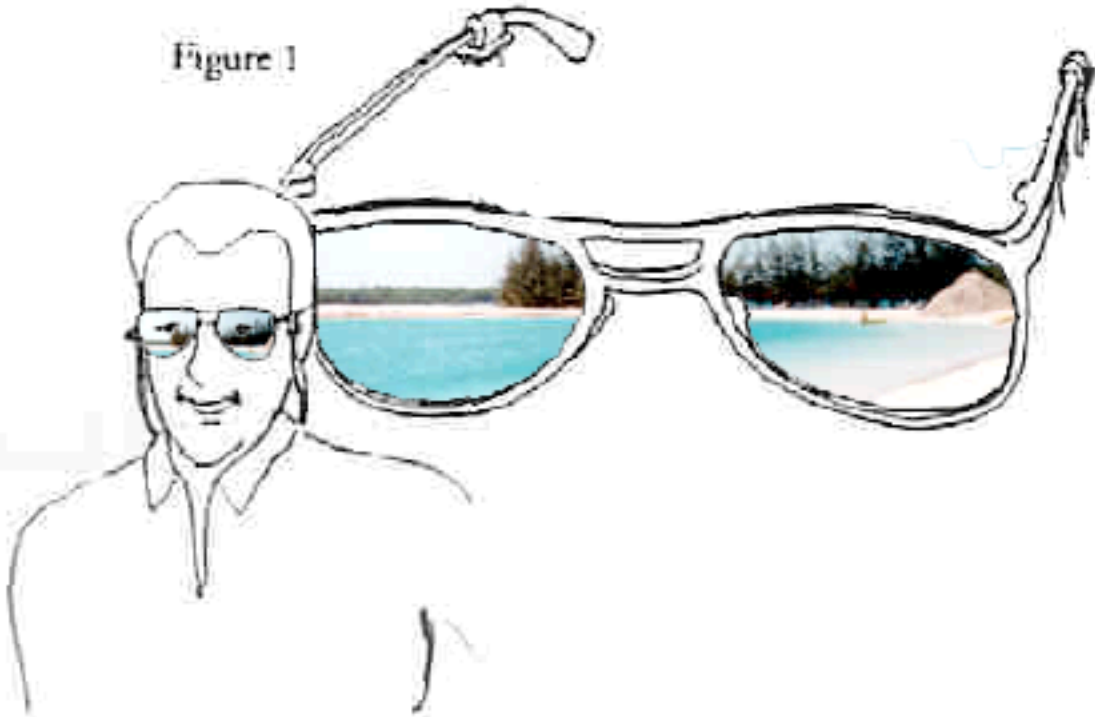

## **I. Beliefs, Ideas, Goals**

**Decommunism is a simplistic, people based vision of the future. In a Decommunist world, the government would support a multiple tiered system. The first tier would consist of those educated to make advancements to society. The second tier would be devoted to supporting the further advancements by the upper class, and if they had the want, they could move themselves to the first tier. The second tier would do less demanding tasks. Businesses would be licensed out to members of the community from the government, allowing for stability while still providing jobs. All property would be government owned and maintained, allowing for a clean, beautiful, and most importantly, safe environment. Each tier would be broken up into orders.
